- STEP #2:** Score a B or better on the AP Calculus entrance test (See PreCalc Instructor for a test date appointment.) **Test must be taken between April 15 and May 15.**
- STEP #3:** Using the back of this form only (do not attach separate sheets), tell why you wish to enroll in Advanced Placement Calculus and explain your commitment to the time, effort, and attitude necessary to be successful in the course. Also include your anticipated college major and the research you have done into the type of math courses needed for you college studies.
- STEP #4:** Commit to completing a summer assignment due on the first day of school
- STEP #5:** You and your parents read and sign the student agreement/parental permission form.
- STEP #6:** Return (1) this form with written essay, (2) the signed parental/student permission form, and (3) your AP Exam fee--a check for \$92 (made payable to TKCS) to the High School Office.

Only students who have re-registered will be permitted to apply for this course.
