## **Ministry Opportunity for Elementary School Families: Host a Chinese Student during our Winter Exchange**

During Sunday, January 28 - Wednesday, February 7, 2018, a group of elementary students from China will be visiting TKCS for their first experience in an American school. They also want to experience American culture, so they would like to stay with families of their American classmates (in grades 3-6).

As many of you are aware, it is illegal in China for anyone--including parents--to provide religious instruction to minors, so this is a huge opportunity for us to share the love of Jesus with these precious children.

Students will arrive at TKCS on 1/28 and depart from TKCS on the morning of 2/7. For the ten days of their stay, host families will be responsible for providing:

- a bedroom with a bed, linens, and towels
- two meals a day on school days; three meals a day on Sunday
- transportation to and from school each day (including Saturday, when students will go on a day trip to NYC with their group leaders)
- love and a willingness to make these students feel at home

Families can take one or two students (same gender); students can share a room but need separate beds. The agency encourages families to take two students if possible to ease homesickness. They provide a \$350 stipend per student to cover hosting expenses.
