Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

This summer the math department at The King's Christian School is requiring students to complete summer packets designed specifically for the math course they will be enrolled in for the 2018-2019 school year. These packets are available for download on The King's Christian School website (www.tkcs.org).

It is extremely important that our students continue to practice their math skills over the summer as many students lose material taught from year to year during those summer days. These packets are reflective of the knowledge that is prerequisite to the course your child will be enrolled in in the 2018- 2019 school year. All students enrolled at The King's Christian School grades 7th through Probability and Statistics will be required to complete the appropriate packet and turn in the packet on the Friday of the first week of school.

Students enrolled in AP Calculus will also have to complete a summer project. Information about the AP Calculus project will be emailed to students by Miss Lopez by the end of June. We encourage you and your child to set up a schedule for completing the packet.

The math department would also like to inform you that all students enrolled in Algebra 1 through AP Calculus will be required to purchase the TI 84 Plus Silver Edition graphing calculator. We realize that these calculators are rather expensive so we want to give families plenty of time to prepared for the cost of the calculators. These calculators, if well cared for, will last your child through college and are accepted calculators for SATs, ACTs, and are also used in our science classes here at TKCS. Please keep in mind that if you have multiple children taking Algebra 1 and 2, Geometry, Pre Calculus, Probability and Statistics, and AP Calculus, each child will need their own calculator.

All students taking 7th grade math, 8th grade math, and Pre Algebra will need to purchase the TI 30X II S scientific calculator.

If you purchase a calculator or any other Texas Instrument supplies during the summer, we ask that you cut out the Texas Rewards Points (similar to box tops for education) located on the back of the package and bring them into school.

If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to contact any of the math teachers here at TKCS. We wish you all a safe and relaxing summer and look forward to seeing you in September.
