

# TRANSPORTATION RELEASE FORM

The Athletic Department of The King's Christian School is responsible for providing athletes with transportation to all school-sponsored athletic events (practices, games, etc.). In some cases, transportation is also provided back to school. However, during times when a school vehicle is unavailable, parents are responsible for the transportation of their athletes. A common example of this is home games where students are transported on the bus to the game, but parents must pick them up at the game site. As a convenience to parents, student drivers are permitted to drive themselves and a sibling to practices and home games and then drive home directly from the site. In rare cases, this is allowed for away games, provided the away game site is in the opposite direction than the school and the driver has written, parental permission to transport themselves. Student drivers are not permitted to transport non-family members, except with written, parental permission from both the parents of the driver and the parents of the passenger.

***Briefly stated, whenever a school bus is provided, athletes need to be on the bus. Any variation of this must meet the guidelines listed in the Athletic Handbook, must be approved by the coach, and must have written, signed, parental permission.***
